

## Kurling for Kids Campaign to Finance priority equipment for its Otorhinolaryngology (ORL) or Ear, Nose and Throat (ENT) department for the Sainte-Justine University Hospital Centre

Sainte-Justine UHC is Canada's largest mother-child university hospital centre and one of the most important centres in North America for specialized and ultra-specialized pediatric care. To maintain its reputation for excellence, Sainte-Justine has a commitment to discover and provide the best possible care for children using the most advanced equipment, to promote health, to provide a welcoming environment for patients and to train the next generation of doctors and caregivers to the highest possible standard.

Sainte-Justine's Otolaryngology Department (ORL) treats and monitors children with ear, nose and throat (ENT) problems. The department sees nearly 11,000 patients a year. In order to provide leading-edge treatment for young patients, the ORL Department is aiming to acquire critical needs equipment.

- An operating microscope with digital display to allow us to perform extremely fine surgical procedures on the outer, middle and inner ear.
- A naso-laryngeal endoscope to help minimize surgical procedures on the larynx and respiratory tract, allowing patients to heal more quickly.
- An endoscopic video system and printer, completing the recording system we purchased recently in order to facilitate teaching of the steps in surgical procedures. The system can be followed on screen and can be used both by pediatricians and by intensive care physicians.
- Instrumentation for clinical fluoroscopy to allow us to perform ear surgery in an outpatient setting without ear patients having to be hospitalized and operated on under general anesthetic.
